## **DONATIONS AND DEDICATIONS POLICY**

### **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this policy is to clearly explain the reasons behind the creation of Manotick's *Remembrance Park* and outline procedures for donations to the Park and the decisions made concerning naming and dedications within the Park

### **PARK FEATURES**

Manotick's *Remembrance Park* will be a place for all citizens to enjoy and remember with gratitude, the contributions made by those who have served their county in wars and peacekeeping missions.

In honour of Canada's 150<sup>th</sup> Birthday celebrations, Remembrance Park gardens will honour all military personnel who served in Canadian wars and peacekeeping mission over the past 150 years. There will be a number of benches donated by local non-profit community groups as well as a special statue from the children of Manotick thanking veterans for their service.

### **YOUR DONATION**

As the Park will be dedicated to all military personnel, there will be no park recognition of, or dedication to, specific individuals. If you would like to recognize a specific veteran, we would encourage you to purchase a brick on the Veterans' Way pathway, sold through Watson's Mill.

Your general donation to the development and maintenance of *Remembrance Park* will be processed through the Manotick Legion, the lead agency in the establishment of the Park. The City of Ottawa is working in conjunction with the Remembrance Park Organizing Committee and will issue income tax receipts to you, for your donation.

Your donation and address information will not be shared with any other agency and is solely collected for the purposes of processing your donation and issuance of a tax receipt.
